- Time Commitment: Undergraduate/postgraduate students in college are expected to commit 8-10 hours weekly to complete activities in a bingo, ensuring sustained effort and impact throughout the engagement period. Professionals in organizations are expected to commit 4 hours a week to conduct a presentation in their organisations on voter awareness.
- Event Organization: Plan and host events within your college/organisation, fostering meaningful discussions on the importance of active participation, inclusion, and information in the electoral process. These events will serve as catalysts for increased voter awareness and engagement among peers.
- Information Dissemination: Actively disseminate relevant information, guidelines, and updates on voter registration and the electoral process through various channels within your college or organization.
- **Community Building:** Foster a sense of community within your college or organization, encouraging open dialogue on civic responsibilities and the power of democratic participation. Motivate and empower your peers to take an active role in shaping the future through their votes.
